	rainbow cauldron	Cross symbol of the Catholic religion in Ireland. It is Celtic in homage to the ancient Irish Celtic religion.
	Harp	Small (90 cm) imaginary creature who is a shoemaker, makes a lot of jokes and keeps a cauldron full of gold at the foot of a rainbow.
